

COVID-19 PROTOCOLS:

Registration & Admission:

- When you arrive at Temple Anshe Sholom (TAS), a greeter will welcome you, sign you in and remind you to self-assess.
- Those who wish to attend must be symptom-free. If you do not feel well or exhibit any symptoms, stay home. Our greeter has been authorized to refuse entry to any individual exhibiting symptoms.
- Any individual who is required by public health to be in quarantine or self-isolation due to a diagnosis of COVID-19, exposure to COVID-19, or travel – will not be allowed to attend services until completion of the full duration of the isolation period.
- Attendance at any indoor service or program at TAS requires either full vaccination against COVID-19 (2 doses and a 2-week waiting period) or a medical exemption for not being vaccinated against COVID-19.

Note: this only applies to those eligible to be vaccinated and implementation is based on the honour system

Service Information:

For Kabbalat Shabbat:

- **The door will be open from 6:30 pm – 7:00 pm**, so please ensure you arrive on time (or a little early, just in case). If there is a line up, please ensure you maintain social distancing. Entry is through the front doors only.
- **The service will run from 7:00 pm – 8:30 pm** in our Main Sanctuary.

For All Services:

- **Where to sit: You will be directed by the ushers to available seats.** Larger “bubbles” (ie. households) may sit together.

- **Masks fully covering from chin to nose** are required at all times while in the building.
- **Ritual objects** including tallitot and kippot should be brought from home. TAS' tallitot and kippot will not be available to borrow.
- **Siddurim and Chumashim** will be available at TAS, however, we strongly encourage you to bring your own if you can.
- **Any person not fully vaccinated (your second shot was received less than 14 days ago) will not be permitted to attend at this time.**

Building Protocols:

- **Social Distancing** of six feet (two metres) is required in all spaces. We encourage you to greet and welcome fellow members, but to avoid shaking hands, hugging, or otherwise physically embracing. Only members of the same household are encouraged to sit together.
- **Masks** are required in all spaces at all times, including during services. While spare masks are available, we encourage you to bring your own mask.
- **Washrooms** will be open and sanitized. We encourage you to only use the lower foyer washrooms rather than the upstairs washrooms.
- **Hand sanitizer** will be available and guests will be required to disinfect their hands upon entry to the building
- Please enter and exit promptly, and *shmooze* outdoors. Linger inside the building is not permitted.
- **Food:** There is no *kiddush* or other food at this time. Outside food or beverages will not be permitted.
- **Enforcement:** These policies will be enforced by TAS staff and volunteers, and any person not cooperating will be asked to leave.
