As you may know, we made the difficult decision at the end of January to discontinue our contract with Third Eye Security due to financial constraints. While we explored alternative options, including a call for security volunteers on February 5, we have not received enough responses. As a result, we are implementing a new security policy, which will take effect on **Friday, March 21**.

New Security Protocol

To ensure the safety of our community, **all individuals**—members and non-members alike—who wish to attend Friday evening and Saturday morning Shabbat services, as well as Religious School parents attending in person on Saturdays, will need to validate their identity in advance by completing [THIS FORM](#).

- **You only need to complete the form once.** Your name will then be added to a security list, which our security volunteers will use for identity verification at the entrance.
- Unfortunately, **if you have not registered** and our volunteer does not know you, we will be unable to let you into the building.
- **Do not let anyone into the building unless you personally know them.** Maintaining situational awareness is critical to keeping our community safe.
- **If you are interested in becoming a security volunteer**, we encourage you to reach out to the Temple Office.
